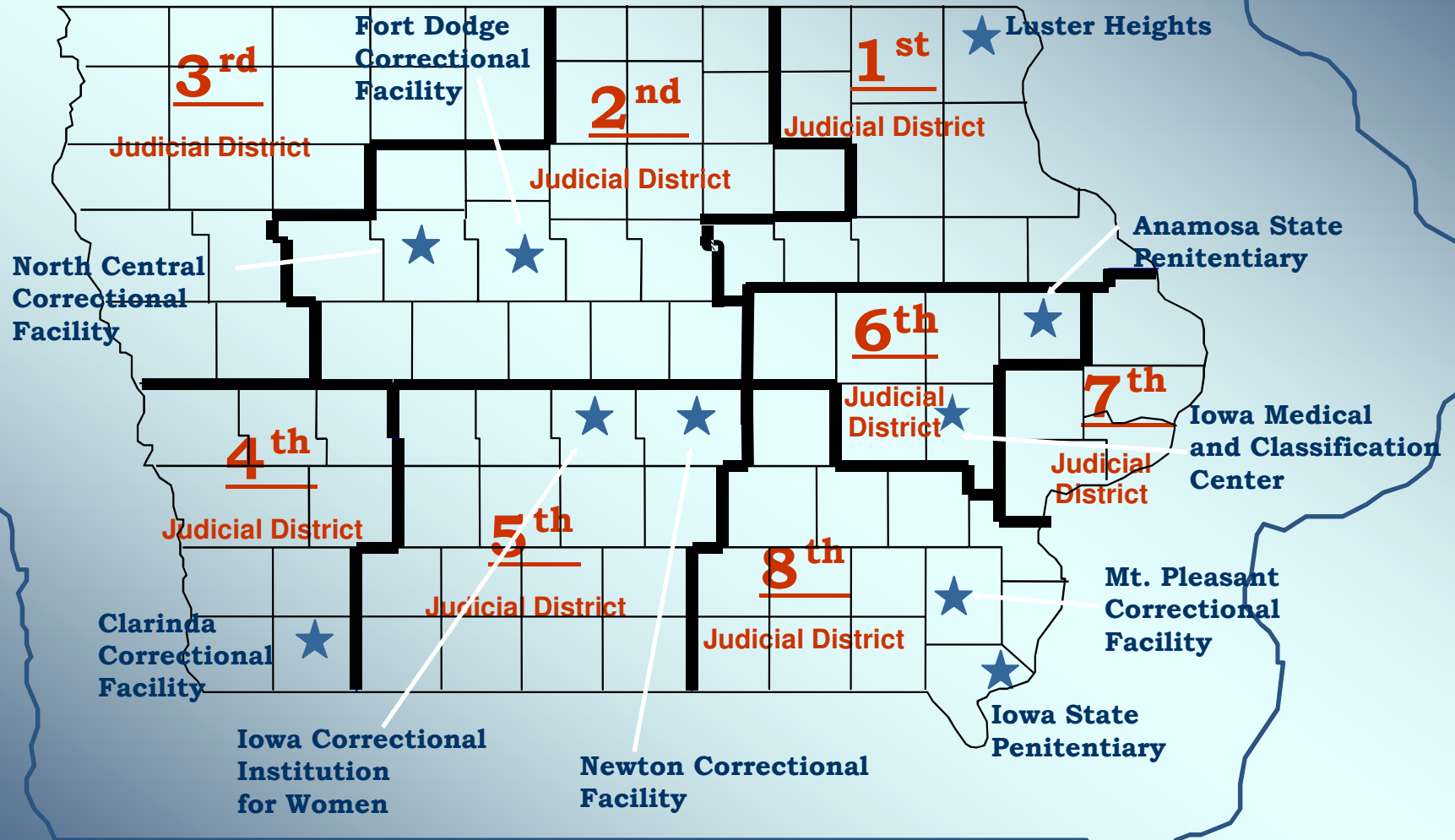


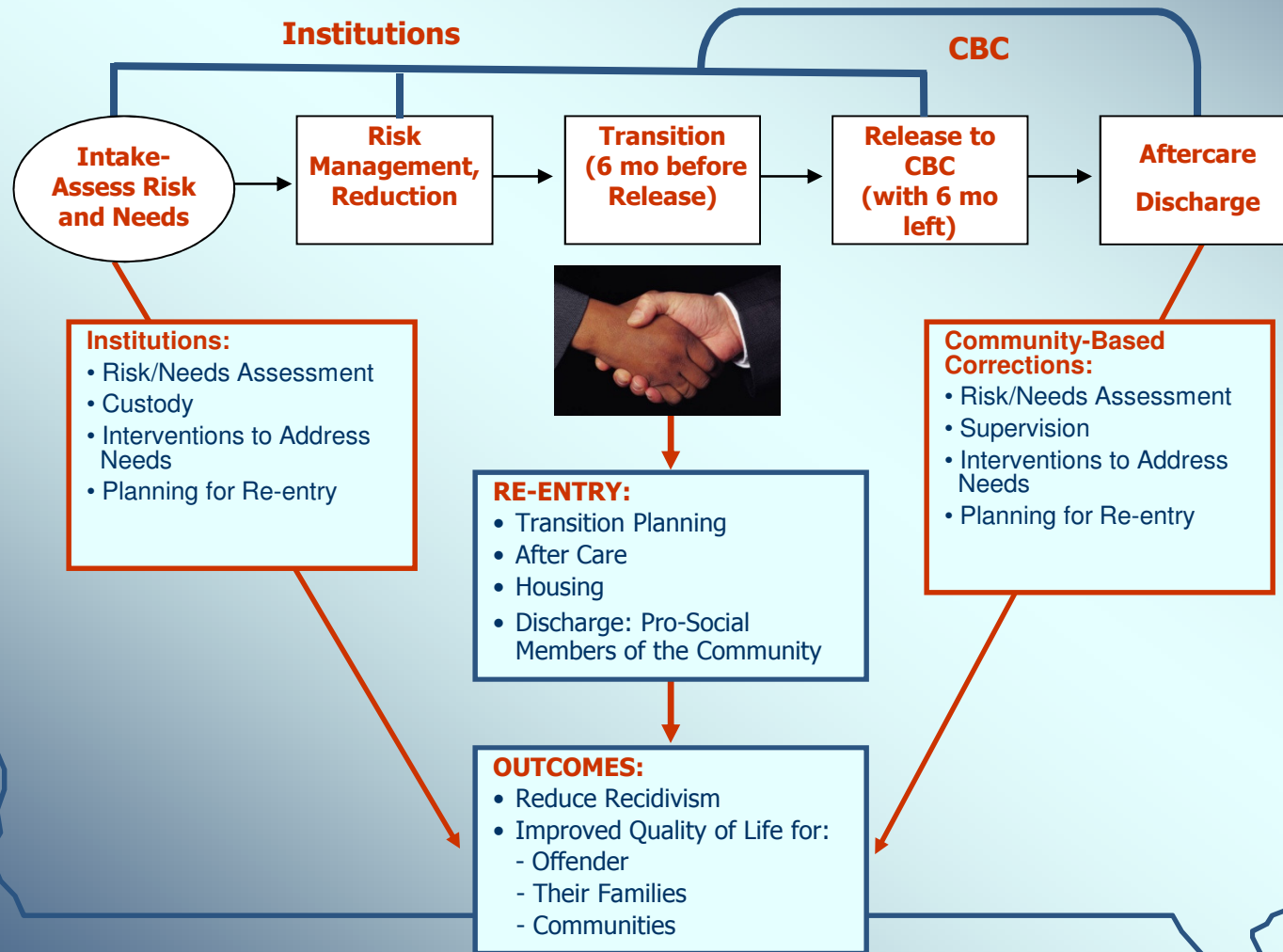
# Reentry in Iowa

We protect the community, staff and offenders from victimization by creating partnerships and utilizing evidence based practices to prepare offenders to be pro-social members of the community without correctional supervision.

# Other Intake Activities

- Foundation of Case Plan developed
- Transition/ Release plan discussed
- Projected Recommendation Date determined

# Risk Management / Risk Reduction

- Assigned to facility that best matches custody, treatment and reentry needs
- Reentry Case Plan negotiated
- Treatment readiness activities include education, vocational training and motivational enhancement
- Interventions to address criminogenic needs
- Reassess and transfer to least restrictive or transition facility as risk reduced

# Transition

- Housed in minimum security/transition facility near release community
- Focus on life skills, meaningful work, family reunification and release planning
- Prepare case for Board of Parole review
- Engage CBC and other community partners in transition/release planning prior to release

# Reentry Goals

- Improve reentry response to special populations
- Successful reentry requires a tiered, flexible step-down approach
- All offenders in the criminal justice system must be managed with successful reentry as the primary goal
- Implement one-stop reentry centers throughout the state
- Establishing partnerships with local, state, federal and faith based and community organizations to effectively assess and address offender needs
- Engage and train all staff to understand and manage offenders in a manner that supports the reentry process
